



BEACH LIFE 2006

In the run up to the Vale Earth Fair's 30th anniversary celebrations this summer, Petit Bôt will once again play host to a one-day live music festival on Sunday 28th May. In its second year at this new location, Beach Life 2006 will have even more to offer.

'After the success of last year, we are trying to expand the scope of the event to involve other arts organisations,' said Rob Roussel, Collective Member.

'As well as bringing over acts from UK and supporting local bands, this year we're working with CinéGuernsey to screen a film later in the day. We're also going to have a few stalls on site and we'd like to hear from anyone who might be interested in setting one up.'

The event begins with a relaxed feel with acoustic sets from 2pm. From 5pm, the Beach Life stage will get underway with an eclectic mix of live bands and DJs, originating from both the UK and Guernsey.

Local boys, Yeboah will be the first band to appear on the main stage. Despite being new on the scene, with their sound compared to Dylan, The Levellers, and early Verve releases, they already have quite a following.

Guernsey's hip-hop talent, Asylum Seekas will take the stage at 7.30pm, followed by a rare opportunity to see Teaspo, Onriv, and Erneck in action as Teaspoonriverneck.

The headline act, Brighton-based, Waxed Apple are sure to warm up the crowd with their mix of strings, percussion, live samples and soulful samples.

The VEF will also be welcoming back VJ Doublethink for the second year running, who will be providing live on-stage visuals after dark.
