DJ sets will be provided by Oneofakind and Karmaloji and undoubtedly one of the highlights of the day will be the live video performance by VJ Russell (of VJamm Allstars and the pioneer of software made famous by Coldcut) at dusk.

Headliners, The Bodysnatchers are formed of two DJs, 30Hz and Baobinga, both of whom are renowned as leading lights in the world of dance music. They have performed across the globe and their music can be heard in leading UK clubs, across the airwaves thanks to BBC Radio 1 and on multi-million selling computer games.

Their performance follows local force, Gay Army, who have taken the Guernsey music scene by storm since their initial assault in July 2005.
